

CFF Licences FAQ

- Q.** I have paid my licence fee online, where is my number?
- A.** Currently the Licence number system is not automated, so usually within a day or so you will be assigned a CFF Licence number. You can look up your number online in the licence listing.
- Q.** My CFF Licence shows an 'n' in the validated column. Why is this?
- A.** CFF Licences are only valid if the athlete is also a member of a branch of the CFF (province). Your CFF Licence status changes to validated when your province identifies you as a provincial member to the CFF.
- Q.** I have a CFF licence but my name does not show up in the competition rankings. I have competed in several events. Why?
- A.** You are required to have a validated CFF Licence prior to competing in an event. The CFF Ranking system rejects ranking results from non-validated athletes. For 2006-2007, following validation, an athlete's ranking results were recovered and they were ranked.
- Q.** I have paid my provincial membership fees and I did not receive a CFF Licence number. Why?
- A.** Did your provincial fee include the CFF Licence Fee? In some provinces, the CFF fee is collected by the province. If this is true for you, check with your provincial registrar to see if your fees have been submitted to the CFF. In some provinces, you are required to get your own licence from the CFF website, while in others, you pay both your provincial membership and CFF Licence fee on the CFF website. Check with your province to see which model is being used
- Q.** I have paid all of my membership and licence fees but my CFF Licence remains not validated.
- A.** Check back in a day or two to see if your Licence has been validated. If not, check with your provincial registrar.
- Q.** I am trying to register for a CFF event (Competition, course etc.) on the CFF website and it rejects my licence number. Why?
- A.** You must have a validated CFF licence prior to starting the registration process. Plan ahead. You should have a licence if you are involved in fencing at any level, so do not leave acquisition until a few hours before you wish to register for an event. You probably will not get it in time.
