Results from this tournament will count toward national Veteran 2010/11 rankings

This tournament will be run in accordance with FIE and CFF rules and regulations subject to the interpretations of the Directoire Technique. There may be mixed fencing in a weapon as dictated by numbers

All fencers are subject to Article t.15 of the FIE Rules and Regulations.

Masks and other equipment will be checked on the piste

Regular fencing attire is required including a sous-plastron which complies with current CFF regulations
